

LET'S NOT LIE, AT LEAST TO OURSELVES!

There are two main types of people. Some accept the truth that is proclaimed, for example, by some religion, but do not seek it themselves, others are in no hurry to believe and seek the truth themselves or become atheists (godless). I am not an atheist. It was important for me to find out what the Truth is. That is why I was "stuck" in the search for the answer for a long time, *What is light?*

I have already written in my book "The Path of Light" that the IDEA OF LIGHT is quite clear in the New Testament. The light should not have been erased from the Creed, but the Catholics erased it. Jesus came to proclaim it, and some popes took it and erased it. Everything is written down. We will return to that topic later. But this was not enough for the Christians. They began to argue among themselves about not the most important things. They were especially worried about *The concept of God* How to explain Him...Who is He? *Alone* whether *Absolute*, the god of philosophers, or maybe he is no more, maybe he is "dead"...When there is no Light, God truly dies.



To acknowledge Jesus' words that GOD IS LIGHT was an insurmountable obstacle to the human mind. A real misery. They saw the Light, but did not see it. They heard His word, but

did not hear the essence. Since Christianity was greatly influenced by the Gnostics, Pythagoreans, Platonists, Neoplatonists, and later Augustinianism/Aristotelianism, it is understandable that separating the wheat from the chaff was and still is difficult.

Ancient people, called pagans, intuitively worshipped the light of the Sun. And if Christians had so much love for EVERYTHING now, the world would be brighter!!! The Sun was the foundation of all creation for them, the demiurge between heaven and man, uniting all people. Worship of the Sun led to the idea of One God. Although those old religions have disappeared, today scientists, well acquainted with the depths of "matter", have no doubt that, for example, the ancient Egyptians thought correctly. Can we imagine our existence without the Sun? Does its electromagnetic radiation not affect us? It does. And how. In ancient times, they did not know this. God forbid, if the Sun throws out an especially large burst of its "wind", disrupting our entire life, all our miraculous inventions, explosive electrical substations and nuclear power plants. Won't that be hell? Is it not coming? What is climate change? All "nature" depends on the action of the Sun's light.

On July 27, 2007, I wrote:

Old Testament, New Testament...What does the word mean?*will*? Linguists explain that a will is an official document that states someone's last wishes. Usually, a personIn a will, a person declares that after death he leaves his property, for example, to his children. What property? Material. What does material property mean? Didn't a person have anything else, that he left only material property, which has nothing to do with the deceased himself? Does a person really leave only material property to another person? Even without a will... Of course, he leaves much more. Not only sweet memories of the past, relationships, but also that feeling in the heart that connected them. Love. If it connected them. It can also leave a bleeding wound in the heart. Such a "will" accompanies a person throughout his life and hurts... All written, material wills burn, rot and turn into nothing. Only the Light of Love remains, which warms the heart.

There is a Testament that, like a master key, unlocks all secret doors, explains and connects everything. For those who believe in the Word of Jesus Christ, perhaps it would be worth opening His Testament, which we traditionally call the New, more often. But why did many churches appear over the millennia, and the Testament of Jesus was interpreted and supplemented with foreign things. His Word faded. It would be difficult to briefly describe those variations of theological philosophizing. And there is no point. Who allowed reason to interfere with the Word of God? Just remember how many religious wars there were, how many fighters died for "their truth"?

And how many wars are still going on today? One mind cannot agree with another mind. The Light shines on all equally, loves all equally, but the human race ignores It.

It took me a lot of time and effort to separate the wheat from the chaff: what the JK said and what Christians did with His Word. Yes, God gave us free will to act, to think. However, it has long been known that man, with his freedom, free thinking, has traveled so far that returning to the Source becomes not only difficult, but also impossible. The distance between the word of man and the Word of God is infinitely great. The Word of God is short and clear, transparent and easy to understand. It is intended for everyone. The Word of God should not even be explained, analyzed. It simply proclaims the Truth. Why do you doubt the Word of God? It was **the first sin**.

The second sin Interpretation of God's Word *according to oneself*. Immediately after Jesus' Ascension, His followers and disciples rushed to spread and explain the Word of God they had heard. However, they did not understand it sufficiently and began to comment on it. *according to oneself* The Holy Spirit was given to the Twelve to carry out this mission. However, those who were not consecrated also joined in the work. The latter began to spread the Good News "without authority" *according to your understanding*. Christians sought to teach the pagans and lost the thread in the tangle of words... On the other hand, people who were not very educated, who did not understand the Word of God very well, were mistaken and misled others. One by one, through each other, they spread half-truths or even untruths. Christians were angry, killed each other, grouped themselves according to their views. And this continues. Some dared to utter crazy words: *God is dead..* (German philosopher JG Fichte) Do you think there were no supporters of him? There were. And not a few. It never occurred to anyone that one must BE SILENT in order to hear God and see His Light within oneself.

Thus, the Church, built on the foundation of Light, gradually began to sink into darkness. Many small churches appeared. Many theologians. And each with his own truth. This is how it is today. Christians can no longer unite around the Holy Word, they are divided and even hostile. The split of the Church of God was **third sin**. The distancing from the LIGHT or the decline is also reflected in our daily lives. The modern Christian church has no leader. It is sick, and its sheep are sick too.

I had planned to analyze the concepts of all Christian churches, but I decided not to do it. It is not worth it. I do not want to contribute to even greater tensions and I have no right to participate in such activities. My goal is one -**to thank the Lord for the Light, which I found in my heart and in His Word**. I don't need anything else. And you believe what you believe, God Himself will lead you to Himself in the most appropriate way.

Do not forget the sacred words, which are called the Word of God. Indeed, if you know the Truth, do not lie at least to yourself! Peace was wished for us by Jesus Christ.
