

## **THE ANTICHRIST PHILOSOPHS ABOUT "SALVATION."**

**Although throughout history, people have invented and practiced many different methods and theories of torturing each other, the act of carrying the cross and crucifixion of Jesus Christ was and remains a symbol of inhumanity. An innocent, righteous, supernatural messenger of God on Earth was tortured in the most brutal and horrific way. Almost all the apostles fled. Only the beloved disciple of Jesus, John, several faithful women (they later came to the tomb and were the first to learn that Christ had risen) and His own Mother stood at the cross with her crucified Son. The Romans themselves, who invented crucifixion, called this execution the most cruel and inhuman. Only runaway slaves and robbers were killed in this way. And God. Having experienced unimaginable suffering, almost losing consciousness from pain, the crucified Lord nevertheless found the strength to turn to the apostle John with a request to take care of His Mother. And this concern, born on the cross, at the very culmination of suffering on Golgotha, is in itself a powerful testimony to how She must have suffered in those hours...**

**For me personally, the most terrible thing in that story is that He was betrayed and was NOT supported until the last moment of His life by His close disciples, except for Mother Mary and, as they say, the most beloved disciple Mary Magdalene. And despite this fact, which no theologian of the Taliban orientation could deny, women in Christianity were the object of contempt, mockery, and all kinds of humiliation. The persecution of "witches" and their burning at the stake revealed the decline of the spirituality of the Christian religion. The Christian male religion still adheres to old standards and does not allow women into its "monopoly". Psychologically, this is a defense, because only by separating from the "source of temptation" can one endure an inhuman lifestyle (celibacy) and fulfill "God's vows". It is an open "secret" that the clergy compensate for this lifestyle with other methods. I will not mention them, because everyone knows what it is anyway. Women - not iron - they survived in their own way and lifted the isolation and humiliation created by the "great righteous." May the Lord forgive them!**



However, and unfortunately, in our time, a new sect of "righteous people" is being born, who know how to treat people. For now, it can be called a sect (although it has its own church, rituals, priests, not recognized by the Vatican, which, although it operates publicly, spreads *own* religious pseudo-ideas, and "*subtly and gently*", as someone wrote, is trying to push "original" standards of lifestyle and worldview onto the people of this world. The aspirations and appetites of that sect to devour, gather, and subjugate as many naive people as possible, often bribing and luring them into the sect's activities, are truly horrifying. It is horrifying because it is a wolf in sheep's clothing that appears to be very intelligent, even humane and just. It is impossible to track down all the moves and secret methods of that wolf, because the wolf and his minions operate under the mask of religious - pseudo-Christianity. Since Christians do not know the history of Christianity and the Teachings of Jesus Christ very well (except at the level of a prayer book), the number of those sectarians can be enormous. Their powers are almost unlimited, because their material and financial resources are constantly being accumulated and everyone who is connected to the Internet or a network of social and financial transactions contributes to this. We will not talk about the psychological impact of these instruments on a person - it has been well analyzed and should be understandable to everyone. So I use this method to convey to you what I realized while analyzing some facts of the history of humanity and religion. In short - this is ***Humanity from time to time falls into the traps of various forms of government and ideologies***.from which terror cannot be freed without shedding rivers of blood. Slavery, feudalism, capitalism, communism, socialism, liberalism,*libertarianism*\*...the latter, which is intensively promoted by the richest aces in the world, means almost nothing to the average person. So I invite you to at least read the link given, paying attention to the criticism of libertarianism. Libertarians declare that human freedom cannot be

is constrained, and state interference in the life of the individual must be minimal. Sounds nice... But considering that governance must be concentrated only in the hands of a small group of people, it makes you cringe. Since a small group of officials (kings, feudal lords) cannot cover large areas of the state, the state becomes unnecessary - it can be divided into fiefs of a certain size, in which each individual "himself" chooses (or rather is selected) how to exist in it. Those who do not want to work - become slaves, those who want something more - have the opportunity to strive for greater heights, prosperity, at the expense of their own freedom, but everyone must obey *for one* order. Slavery or feudalism are acceptable models of government for libertarians. Feuds are easier to maintain than to control the entire state, so this method is more justified. There is no hope of escaping from feudal oppression. That is where freedom ends. Some thrive in fabulous wealth, others are enslaved by it. Mimetic desires (wanting what another has) are practically eliminated, attributed to sin. Here, innovative "Christianity" comes to the rescue. Libertarians base this on the example of Jesus Christ (... *hypocritically interpret His words, because Jesus was not speaking against wealth, but about attachment to wealth: In the Gospels, Jesus utters one of the most shocking sentences about man's relationship with wealth: "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."* (Matthew 19:24; Mark 10:25; Luke 18:25). *This hyperbole, which survives in the three synoptic accounts, is often understood as a categorical judgment on all who have more than others. However, the context of the Gospels shows that Jesus is not talking about economic status, but about the inner state of a person. Wealth is not evil in itself, but it can become a spiritual burden that closes a person's heart to God and neighbor.*) Unfortunately, feudal lords are not the confidants of Jesus Christ, even if they claim to be. At first, there might be believers in the "messiahs", but I don't believe that this can be a mass voluntary phenomenon unless a person becomes imprisoned in a state of one choice: either-or. Either you use the status of an unemployed "parasite"

(*according to the philosophy of Peter Thiel-C.*) and you receive certain benefits (*e.g. to a card-C.*) and certain goods, or you become a slave and that's it. So, the whole system turns into a concentration camp, because you yourself chose such service. You went to their organized rallies, parties and lectures, even "masses", you voted for their political candidates (for example, for D. Trump), you took money from the hands of Satan... so there is nothing to be ashamed of if you fell into his net. I am not fantasizing. This is what journalists say about the lectures of Mr. Peter Thiel, a German-American businessman, Silicon Valley "godfather", venture capitalist, multi-billionaire, philosopher, libertarian...

# FROM BYTES TO FAITH: A TECHNOLOGY GIANT "A VARIANT OF CHRISTIANITY"

Journalist and essayist John Mac Ghlionn<sup>2</sup> studies psychology and social relationships, with an interest in social dysfunction and media manipulation. His work has appeared in the New York Post, The Sydney Morning Herald, Newsweek, National Review, and other publications. In one publication, in 2025, he published an article: "**Peter Thiel's gospel of fear - control sold as salvation.**" And he continues: "Peter Thiel has always been known for his contradictions. The billionaire who created modern state surveillance tools is now launching a lecture series on the Antichrist. Four sold-out private sessions in San Francisco are dedicated to a figure long associated with deception and domination. The irony is hard to miss unless you have had your sanity surgically removed. For decades, Thiel has invested in technologies that give governments new powers to monitor, measure and track the lives of their citizens." Another journalist, Adrian Daub,<sup>2</sup> As if continuing his colleague's thoughts, he explains that Peter Thiel philosophized about this in his lectures, *what* could be the Antichrist, and warned of the impending Armageddon event. He, Peter Thiel, a political figure and technology investor, is worried about the Antichrist. It could be Greta Thunberg<sup>3</sup>. And here he is, only "*little orthodox christian*" (not true - he is a representative of heterodoxy thinking - hypocritically contradicting the letter of Holy Scripture - C.), thinks that the prophet of the end of the world may already be (!!!) among us, (again referring to Greta Thunberg - C.) and that such things as international agencies, environmental protection and technological restrictions may accelerate his (understand - Antichrist - C.) rise. Such a discussion of Thiel's lectures supposedly reveals the concerns of one of the most influential people in Silicon Valley and the "US". The journalist aptly notes that "**Peter Thiel's informal lectures on the Antichrist say more about him than about Armageddon.**" Thiel himself states that he seeks to focus on "the most common and dramatic interpretation of the Antichrist: an evil king, tyrant, or anti-Messiah who appears in the end times"...

Unfortunately, Thiel's own investments and projects are not intended for the benefit of people, providing services, but rather for the purpose of making them *to sort* Thiel's algorithm databases replace dialogue and mutual trust. It resembles a control network. **Thiel's venture capital arm, Founders Fund, shows the kind of companies the technocrat fund backs—namely, those that deeply permeate everyday life. Their pattern is clear: from finance to biotech to defense..** A call to invest in systems that categorize, codify, and control. These are not neutral tools. They collect data on how people shop, travel, speak, even think. They flag visible risks, they decide what behaviors are worth rewarding, and other options are silently “closed.”

And now Thiel is explaining to his audience about the Antichrist, warning that he will not march with horns and guns, but will creep in silently, using the fear of catastrophe – nuclear war, artificial intelligence, climate collapse – to justify tighter controls. He argues that endless talk of apocalypse would pave the way for global domination. Listen, because Thiel's warning sounds like a self-portrait, the journalist notes. “Thiel talks about catastrophe all the time, about imminent destruction. **But at the same time, it finances**

**precisely the machinery that turns fear into domination. The contradiction is far from subtle. It is the essence of his empire."**

**For Christians, the idea of the Antichrist has special significance because the Gospel speaks of freedom, not fear:**

"St. Paul: 'God did not give us a spirit of fear, but of power, love and a sound mind'" (2 Timothy 1:7) These are words that show that God gives strength, love and reasonableness spirit. <sup>These</sup> **the words of the apostle Paul directly contradicts Thiel's philosophy.** Where the Holy Scripture emphasizes love, where Christ promised mercy, Thiel promises power and fear (the influence of S. Kierkegaard is evident here - C.).

America was strong in its belief that no one person or institution should have too much influence over another. This country created a system of checks and balances, a separation of powers, and rights that no government could take away. All of this was designed to prevent tyranny. **Thiel's vision goes in the opposite direction. He advocates systems that promise leaders a godlike ability to see everything at once. He presents this as progress.**

Thiel often quotes the Ten Commandments, arguing that the first and last – "*worship God*" and "*do not covet another's property*" – are the most important. (*Exodus 20:17 speaks of man's inner desires related to material values* – C.). However, in doing so he **skips orders** that bind people to one another: to love one's neighbor, to honor one's parents, to reject lies, greed, and violence. **Those "omissions" speak volumes about Thiel's model of "religion."** His "profession of faith" looks upward and inward, but rarely to the surroundings. **He values purity and ownership, while ignoring the call to love one's neighbor.**

Christ comforted, taught, and rescued the poor and weak, lightening their burdens, not by magnifying them. His gospel was a gospel of compassion, reconciliation, and selfless love. Thiel's "gospel" lacks these values. He values a vertical connection to God but neglects a horizontal connection to humanity.

**Thiel sends a message to the Church:** can Thiel's counterfeit "gospel" be accepted into the Sanctuary? His "philosophies" are important outside the church as well. A free society cannot survive if it entrusts its future to men who speak of impending threats while at the same time creating systems that centralize power. Thiel speaks of prophecy, but his projects are a real warning: if we listen to him, we may face not salvation but enslavement, not freedom but the chains of slavery.

As long as free speech is still respected in the world, in democratic countries, we need not fear Thiel's "antichrist." However, we cannot lose our vigilance.

The Vatican knows what Peter Thiel was doing in Rome. The Catholic newspaper *Avvenire*, which has close ties to the Vatican, called Thiel an "agent of chaos." After his lectures, non-religious protesters gathered outside the Italian Defense Ministry in Rome, waving a bilingual banner that read: "Peter Thiel out of Rome. War technologists out of Rome."

By daring to spread his words beyond the Vatican's doorstep, the tech titan has drawn the ire of several Vatican institutions, including the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas and the Dominican University of Rome. They have denied any connection to Thiel. However, Thiel's talks in Rome were sponsored by the Vincenzo Gioberti Cultural Association, which describes itself as an association dedicated to the renewal of Italian political culture. The association has drawn criticism from the Vatican and Catholic scholars, although Catholic universities have publicly denied their involvement. And who can deny that there were not some "cultural figures" who were even very receptive to Thiel's message? If a small sum can bribe an ordinary politician, then entire religious communities can be bribed with millions... who do not understand the essence of "Thiel's truth."

"Thiel - Silicon Valley entrepreneur, co-founder of PayPal, architect of Palantir, financier of crucial political campaigns in the United States - came to Rome not only as a man of technology, but also as an interpreter of the Apocalypse," *variety.com* The portal was told by the famous Jesuit theologian, writer and journalist Antonio Spadaro, who at one time conducted a series of individual conversations with Martin Scorsese (they were published in the book "Dialoghi sulla fede" ("Dialogues on Faith")). Spadaro said: "Thus the religious horizon is gradually emptying of its content of faith: what matters is not the return of Christ, but the identification of the Antichrist as a concrete political force. The Gospel becomes a tool of geopolitical analysis." Father Paolo Benanti, who advises the Pope on artificial intelligence, wrote in his published essay that **Thiel acted as a "political theologian of Silicon Valley"**. Benanti wrote: "All of Thiel's actions can be... interpreted as a prolonged act of heresy against the liberal consensus: a challenge to the very foundations of civic coexistence, which he (Thiel) considers obsolete." The headline of the article was: **"American Heresy: Should Peter Thiel Be Burned at the Stake?"**

It is worth mentioning A. Spadaro's 2017 article entitled "Evangelical Fundamentalism and Catholic Integralism", in which he criticized supporters of United States President Donald Trump. The article was approved by Cardinal Secretary of State Pietro Parolin and was published in the Jesuit journal "La Civiltà Cattolica". He described American political life as Manichaean and

claimed that the Trump administration was responsible for promoting "apocalyptic geopolitics", comparing American conservative Christians to ISIS. Spadaro also criticized American Catholics who supported the conservative movement and Trump in particular. Spadaro later published an article criticizing Trump adviser Steve Bannon for his ideological ties to Calvinist theologian RJ Rushdoony. Condemning Church Militant for its "shocking rhetoric", Spadaro claimed that American Catholics and Protestants were promoting a "conflict ecumenism" on abortion, same-sex marriage and religious education in schools, which also included a "xenophobic and Islamophobic vision", transforming it into an intolerant "ecumenism of hate". The article also criticized conservatives for being uncritical of militarism, capitalism and the arms industry, and for ignoring the natural environment. **In 2026, it was revealed that Stephen Kevin Bannon** (American political strategist, media executive, (Trump campaign executive director in 2016 and chief White House strategist after the election, who was arrested and charged with fraud in August 2020. Trump pardoned him in 2021, and they later fell out.) **is the main target of Spadar's criticism**, who tried to collaborate with sex offender Jeffrey Epstein to "overthrow" Pope Francis.

Let's return to P. Thiel, S. Bannon's "ideological friend". When Thiel spoke about contemporary political trends with apocalyptic narratives at a closed event at the Paris Academy of Moral and Political Sciences in early 2026, his main emphases were condensed into a few assertions: "The end of modernity", the exhaustion of Enlightenment progress, the collapse of faith in reason, institutions and global cooperation due to the power of conflict and technology. Progress is hindered by the stagnation of innovation, the growth of bureaucracy, the rise of supranational organizations."

(I will recall Trump's crackdown on state-sponsored organizations.) And here, according to Thiel, the danger of the 21st century Antichrist arises: This is not a "mad scientist" but a "false protector" promising peace and security through total control and a risky halt to progress. He does not accept those who demand strict regulation of technology and climate in the name of universal "salvation". He calls them "Legionaries of the Antichrist" who promote ideas that lead to "world government" and stagnation. For example, Greta Thunberg symbolizes "climate activism" for him, and Eliezer Yudkowsky - AI security. Thiel fears that a catastrophe could arise from the conflict between uncontrolled progress and the "Antichrist" (a global dictatorship that halts development). Geopolitical conflicts, he says, pose the risk of war

and strict global regulation that will limit freedom. Meanwhile, that's all he wants. Thiel's entire "religion" is based on fear, scaring the whole world.

Armageddon and the Antichrist. That fear gives him a chance to develop AI, the military industry, and tracking technologies that can "save" humanity.

It's not worth being surprised by Peter Thiel's transhumanist nonsense, although vigilance is necessary, given his inexhaustible financial resources and influence over politicians. He can "cook porridge" certain and even very secret studies of human consciousness. Not just like Thiel, many people in the world, especially powerful dictators, desire immortality and long-term health, but for now, these are just illusions. To subject human consciousness to technological regulation without knowing it, *What is consciousness?*, it is unlikely that such projects would succeed. Thiel's intention to "liquidate the state", in America or somewhere in Africa, is phantasmagorical. It is difficult to imagine people in the 21st century surrendering to total AI control, slavish obedience, for the sake of the well-being of exceptional "superhumans". Peter Thiel forgets that the human system was given to him from above. **He will never be able to eliminate God. Thiel, in his analysis of Christianity, missed the most important thesis of Jesus Christ: GOD IS SPIRIT. A tech mogul with no spiritual experience is walking naked across slippery ice and blowing everyone's minds. He needs to be stopped. How? This is a test of your awareness.**

The Antichrist is not Greta, but Peter Thiel and co. His guard works for him. Can't you see this, watching the behavior of Trump, Putler and other dictators? And here, in our small state, supporters of the Antichrist are raising their heads.
